VIP TABLES £80 per table, for the whole duration of the festival, inside a Marquee with a superb view of the Main Arena and dance floor. Price includes up to 4 chairs. Tickets for the festival must be purchased in addition to the table. Please phone 01923 282725 to book a table, as this can't be booked online.

ARENA BOX £150 for the whole duration of the festival. Your own private, undercover box, on the main Arena, with a great view of the stage. Each box is suitable for between 2 to 12 people to use comfortably. The box doesn't come furnished but you may bring your own chairs as required. Tickets for the festival must be purchased in addition to the arena box. Please phone 01923 282725 for more info and to book a box, as this can't be booked online.

Answers to frequently asked questions about the CAMP SITES:

- **CAMPSITE A** – (Bronze Site) is right next to the Main Arena. Has showers, toilets & water points, and is near to the camp site shop. Please note in campsite A, Bar-Be-Queing and cooking using any naked flame is not allowed. Also in campsite A, cars can't park next to tents, and there will be a separate car parking area. (cars can stay with caravans)
- **CAMPSITE B** – (Gold Site) Recommended for families. This site is about 360 metres from the Main Arena and has showers, toilets & water points, etc. In camp site B you are allowed to have a small Bar-be-Que as long as the fire is contained within a purpose built BBQ and is at least 5cm off the ground. You must have a bucket of water or a fire extinguisher near to the BBQ at all times whilst in use, and not leave any BBQ or cooking appliance unattended until it is completely cold. In campsite B, cars can park next to tents. A free shuttle-bus is provided from campsite B to the main Arena and back.
- Campsite space can only be booked and used by people with full-weekend tickets (no camping available for day ticket holders).
- A campsite plot is needed for each tent, caravan or campervan (not per person).

Answers to frequently asked questions about the CHILDRENS TICKETS:

- People 17 years and over require an Adult ticket.
- Child ages are on day of event.
- One child 16yrs or under is Free, with each adult ticket booked.
- If your child looks older than 16, please bring some I.D. to prove age to avoid confusion at the gate.
- All Children 16 & under must be accompanied by an adult.

DAY TICKETS

- Single Day ticket availability is limited, to ensure all those who wish to buy weekend festival tickets are able to do so.

ALL TICKETS ARE SOLD SUBJECT TO THE RHYTHM FESTIVAL TERMS & CONDITIONS.

Please read through the following information and by purchasing your tickets you confirm that you agree.

For the full terms and conditions please contact us to request a copy. The following information is applicable to the **RHYTHM FESTIVAL**.
(Other events at Twinwood have different T&Cs)

1. **Tickets.** When you receive your tickets, please check they are correct and put them in a safe place, and remember where they are! Tickets can't be replaced if lost.
2. **Wristbands.** Your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband on arrival at the festival. The wristband, not the ticket, is what will allow you to gain entry into the site. The wristband must be worn at all times during the duration of your stay. Wristbands can't be replaced if lost or if taken off..
3. **Dogs and other animals** are NOT allowed to be brought into the site.
4. **Food and Drink.** Food and drink from outside is not allowed to be taken into the Arena. There is a large selection of very good, high quality caterers onsite, serving all types of hot and cold foods, and include healthy and vegetarian options. The bars are stocked with a large range of beer, lager, cider, wine, spirits, and soft drinks, and are at Pub prices. Tea and Coffee can be found at many locations around the site.
5. **Glass.** For safety reasons No glass items, such as bottles, drinking glasses, glass containers, etc are allowed into the showground / Arenas. Cans are also not allowed.
6. **Bar Be Ques.** In campsite B only, Cooking, using small barbeques, which are positioned off the ground is permitted by caravan and campers. (site B is the campsite further away from the Arena). **Bar-be-queing in campsite A is not allowed.** All persons in campsite B intending to cook food or have a BBQ must have either a fire extinguisher or a bucket of water or sand situated close to the BBQ whilst in use. BBQs must not be left unattended until the appliance is completely cold. Fires must be contained in a purpose made Barbeque, be at least 5cm off the ground, and be operated in a safe and responsible manner, and kept at a safe distance away from tents. Fires on the ground are not permitted. Bar-be-queing and cooking using a naked flame is not permitted in campsite A (the campsite next to the main Arena) nor in the Arena, or anywhere else on the showground, or by those who are not caravanning or camping onsite.
7. **Twinwood Campsite facilities.** There are a number of permanent flush toilet blocks, and a number of mobile toilet cubicles. There are mobile shower units, Elsan points, Fresh water points, and the campsites have lighting in. There is a shop in the Arena selling basic groceries, toiletries, newspapers and cigarettes etc. Twinwood Arena campsites are situated in an elevated position and have wonderful scenic views across Bedfordshire. Water for the festival is from Twinwood's own supply and is a scarce resource, please bear this in mind and keep showers short and ensure water points are not left running. There are no electric hook up points. **Camp site A** is right next to the main Arena. BBQs are not permitted in site A, and those camping in site A will be allocated a separate car parking area, away from tents. **Camp site B** is approx 360metres from the showground. Small BBQs are allowed in site B. Cars park next to tents in Camp site B.
(Other campsites are situated locally and may have different facilities, see the **accommodation page** on our website)
8. **Gazebos and Large Umbrellas** may NOT be taken into the arena, as they can cause considerable distress to other people who are sitting behind them! (see picture) Also, in windy conditions gazebos and large umbrellas quickly become dangerous.
9. **Clothing advice.** Please note, the Arena is grass, and the pathways are stony. Remember that we cannot predict the weather so please bring clothing for all eventualities. A sun hat is often useful. The evening performances end late, and a warm jacket will be useful at the end of the evening.
10. **Furniture.** A limited amount of seating is provided around the catering areas and around the bars. You may bring blankets and lightweight folding chairs if you wish. Other furniture such as tables are NOT allowed to be taken into the Arena for safety reasons.



11. **Photography / Filming.** Cameras for personal use are welcome, but no professional video recording, sound recording or professional photography allowed. The Rhythm Festival has its own official photographer and it is a condition of entry that festival goers consent to being photographed and understand these pictures may be used in future promotional material.
12. **Disabled visitors.** We have disabled mobile toilets close to the Arenas, and disabled car parks. We have ramps onto the Arena decking bar area. For disabled camping visitors, if you have a disabled badge, we will do our best to accommodate your needs. You must request disabled camping at the time of booking, and the pitches closest to the facilities are strictly first come, first served and are limited in number. Please note that Rhythm Festival is an outdoor music festival, and Twinwood Arena is situated on an original WWII airfield. The surface of the Arena, car parks and campsites is grass, and the pathways and area near the museums are original tracks from WWII. The distance to the disabled campsite to the main Arena is approx 50m. The main Arena stage to the 2nd stage is approx 300m. (see site plan). The pathways are now quite stony, and some wheelchair users or people who are unsteady on their feet may need assistance.
13. **Entry Times.** This will be included with the information when you receive your tickets.
14. **Car Parking** is free, and there is plenty of it on site.
15. **For Directions** to the event. See the *how to find us* page on our website
16. **A first aid and paramedic team** are on site during the festival.
17. **Tickets are Non-Refundable.**
18. **If you experience any difficulties** or have any problems at all, whilst on the site, please first report to the security stewards who are in attendance at the festival for the whole duration, day and night.
19. **All scheduled bands & artistes** are contracted and The Rhythm Festival accepts no responsibility if an act fails to attend, or at the time scheduled.
20. **Trading.** The selling of goods, distribution of leaflets and advertising, etc is strictly forbidden and can only be carried out by those official traders who have the permission of the Rhythm Festival and Twinwood Events Ltd.
21. **No dangerous items allowed into the site.** This includes fireworks, flamethrowers, knives, etc and anything else that could be considered dangerous.
22. **No illegal substances allowed into the site.**
23. **Security Staff** have the right to search people / bags at their discretion.
24. The Rhythm Festival and Twinwood Events Ltd will not accept liability for personal damages, losses or injuries sustained at this event - including damage and losses to property and motor vehicles.
